

## Warranty Deed

Know all men by these presents: That the Reorganized Church of Jesus Christ of Latter Day Saints, a Corporation organized under the Laws of Iowa, with its Principal place of business at Lamoni, Decatur County, in said State, for and in consideration of the sum of One Thousand fifty and ~~no~~<sup>00</sup> to it in hand paid by J.W.A. & sons, David Anderson & C.M. Bass, Trustees of the County of Decatur in State of Iowa does hereby sell and convey unto the said Trustees and their successors in office the following described Real Estate, situated in the County of Decatur and State of Iowa, to wit:

Two (2) acres of land lying adjoining and on the west side of Rose Hill cemetery in west Lamoni said county, and particularly described as follows: Beginning at a point on the line in the center of the Public Highway at the south east corner of the So. West Quarter (S.W. 1/4) of Section No three (3) town Sixty Seven (67) Range Twenty Seven (27) west, thence due north on said line forty (40) rods, thence due west Eight (8) rods, thence due south forty (40) rods, thence due east to place of beginning except (8) rods. The same for Cemetery purposes.

And the said Reorganized Church does hereby covenant to warrant the title to the afore described premises against the lawful claims of all persons whomsoever.
