Rose Hill Cemetery Decoration Rules

- All plantings, markers, or benches require prior approval by contacting the sexton¹
- Only permanent decorations² are allowed during mowing season from March 15 to November 15, with the exception of special rules for Memorial Day and burials
- Non-permanent decorations³ are allowed throughout the cemetery from May 15 to June 15, for Memorial Day
- Non-permanent decorations³ are allowed for the first two weeks on a new burial site
- Worn or improperly placed decorations may be removed by the caretakers
- Keep dogs on a leash and dispose of dog waste responsibly outside of cemetery
- The cemetery is not liable for loss or damage to vases or decorations

²Permanent decorations are those attached to base stone or a permanent fixture, such as an attached vase, a wrought iron stand or shepherd's hook

³Non-permanent decorations are those that are separate from the base stone, such as wreaths or containers placed on the ground
